What is Community Cars?

Community cars is a car based service for residents of Dacorum who are unable to use public transport or taxis due to mobility or medical reasons, permanent or temporary.



Community Cars functions through the generous and caring support of volunteer drivers who use their own cars to help fellow residents to get out and about.

Individuals will be required to register with Community Cars as a client, involving answering a few basic questions such as name, address, disability and special needs etc..

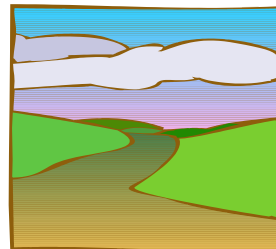
What sort of journeys can be taken?

All types of journey will be considered such as:

- Hospital or Doctor appointments
- Visits to sick friends or relatives
- Dental appointments
- Visits to support groups
- Visits to a shopping centre
- Leisure destinations such as Community Centres, Libraries, Hairdressers etc

Any time seven days a week

May be local or long distance, regular such as weekly or one-off



What does it Cost?

A realistic charge, based on journey miles, will be agreed with the client at the time of booking. There is a minimum charge of £7.00.
