# Hemel Hempstead May - August 2025 Programme

The trips listed in this program are for people living in Hemel Hempstead, Markyate, Flamstead, Great Gaddesden, Kings Langley, Chipperfield & Bovingdon.

#### **Mobility Coding**

All trips are coded to aid you in identifying the amount of walking involved. All trips are accessible to people with mobility difficulties.

**Easy**—very minimal walking involved, accessing the minibus and venue only i.e. lunch, theatre trip.

**Medium**—a small amount of walking around the venue is involved i.e. garden centre.

**Moderate**—a moderate amount of walking around the venue i.e. a museum.

Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle - please look out for this symbol to find wheelchair accessible trips

Please advise us of your mobility requirements when booking in order that we may be able to plan appropriately for the trip.

#### **Accessibilty**

Our minibus is fully accessible with a passenger lift, those with mobility difficulties should be able to access the trips. We are able to take 1 wheelchair user per trip providing patrons can transfer to a seat in the minibus.

#### **Booking your Trips**

#### Lines open on Tuesday 29 April from 10am - 2pm.

- No bookings will be taken before this date. Places are limited, and seats are offered on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Trips will only run if the minimum number of passengers have booked a seat. For trips requiring a ticket or entrance fee the fee must be paid at the time of booking. If a trip is shown to be fully booked, a reserve list will be kept, and we will contact you if a place becomes available.
- Your pick-up time will be given to you closer to the time of the trip. Please be available 15 mins either side of your pickup time.
- Please advise us of mobility requirements when booking

#### **Cancellations**

Please provide us with at least 3 working days notice if you need to cancel a booking.

If less than 3 days notice is given refunds will not be given. If the trip has an entrance fee or ticket paid for in advance will not be refunded.

If a trip is cancelled, we will credit your account or offer a full refund.

#### Volunteers

All of our trips will be driven by our volunteers. We will also provide a volunteer passenger assistant to support members whilst on the trip, please note our volunteer assistants are not healthcare workers.

# **Wheelchair Accessible Transport**

#### Do you use a wheelchair?

Do you find it impossible to travel on public transport?

Is it hard for you to transfer to a car or taxi?

Would you like to get out and about more often?

If the answer is yes, then Community Transport can support you through our Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV), which enables wheelchair users to travel without transferring.

#### Who can use the service?

Anyone who is dependent on a wheelchair and cannot transfer to use cars, taxis or public transport.

#### Who can drive the vehicle?

Friends, relatives or carers may drive the vehicle as long as they are over the age of 21, subject to completing our simple registration process.

They must also receive training on using the equipment prior to the first booking.

Alternatively, you can hire a vehicle with a volunteer driver.

#### What sort of journeys can be taken?

The service can be used for:
Hospital or Doctor appointments
Healthcare appointments
Day Centres and Specialist Needs Clubs
Social purposes
Shopping



Any time seven days a week

May be local or long distance, regular such as weekly or one-off

The Community Transport office is open five days a week Monday to Friday 9.00am to 3.00pm
